# Supplementary electoral regulations 2026

The electoral committee for the elections of 2026 exist of:

- Nele Vankevelaer
- Kris Metdepenningen
- Jonas Verlinden

They are elected as electoral committee 2026 in the General Assembly of 12 December 2025. These regulations supplement the electoral regulations, which are specified in the internal regulations from articles 75 to 145.

Furthermore, the following names are used:

- Industria for Studentenvereniging Industria vzw
- KC26 for electoral committee 2026
- Fakbar for De Fakbar vzw (better known as Recup)

- Art 1. In all of the communication with KC26, you must use the following salutations. These salutations apply only for communication regarding elections and related activities. This rule applies to both serious and fun teams. The salutations are the following:
- Nele Vankevelaer: "Hoogwaardigheidsbekledende voorzitter"
  - Kris Metdepenningen: "Hoogwaardigheidsbekledende ondervoorzitter"
  - Jonas Verlinden: "Hoogwaardigheidsbekledende secretaris"
  - The complete KC26: "Eerambtsverhevenheidsdragende Kiescomité"
- Art 2. All the official communication with KC26 must be done by email to [kc@industria.be](mailto:kc@industria.be).
- Art 3. Every team (serious or fun) is prohibited from making deals on behalf of Studentenvereniging Industria vzw, Industria vzw or Industria. It is also prohibited to make deals that have an effect on Industria in either the short or long term.
- Art 4. Every serious team must identify themselves as a candidate praesidium in external communications. All the communication must happen in their own name. Kiesweek Industria, KU Leuven Campus Groep T Leuven, Faculteit Industriële Ingenieurswetenschappen KU Leuven, or KU Leuven may be mentioned if [kc@industria.be](mailto:kc@industria.be) is in BCC.
- Art 5. §1. It is strictly forbidden to contact companies before receiving the list of the "Not to be contacted companies". This list has to be requested by every team via an email to [kc@industria.be](mailto:kc@industria.be). This list is flexible and subject to change.
- §2. If a team does contact a company that is on this list without requesting written permission of KC26, the team may be forced to discontinue its collaboration with this company.
- Art 6. Calls from official KU Leuven Campus Groep T devices are strictly prohibited in the rooms GT 01.4.01/1, GT 91.P1.13 and GT 92.P2.06. These are respectively the Industria room, the coursebook service and the support room. Any other calls from such devices must be reported to KC26.
- Art 7. Every serious team must maintain an open accounting, which has to be closed by the end of the next academic year, free of debt. There has to be a margin of at least 10% of the total income, with a maximum of €1500 (ONE THOUSEND FIVE HUNDER EUROS).

- Art 8. §1. A fun team is recognized by KC26 if it organizes at least one KC26-approved activity.  
§2. The maximal contribution of Industria per fun team is based on the number of registered members at the registration deadline. This amount will be reimbursed by May 31, 2026.
- Art 9. The fun teams will receive sponsorship if and only if they can submit an invoice or a series of invoices to KC26. The total amount of these invoices must match the amount provided by Industria, with a margin of €5 (FIVE EURO).
- Art 10. Any team meeting of a team (serious or fun) within the KU Leuven Campus Groep T must be notified to KC26 at least one day (24 hours) in advance. An emergency meeting cannot be held in the KU Leuven Campus Groep T buildings.
- Art 11. The serious team(s) need to be present in full at the overdrachtscontus. All the members of the serious team must dress as a specific word from their letter. This word will be communicated to each member by KC26 before May 9, 2026. Any member absent or not properly dressed may be subject to sanctions by KC26.
- Art 12. §1. A location request can be submitted by any serious team but must be submitted by KC26. In the event of a conflict, KC26 chooses who will have priority. This is final.  
§2. The chosen location must be communicated by KC26 to all the teams (serious and fun), regardless of the origin of the request.
- Art 13. §1. Every team (serious and fun) can use the Industria vehicle. The team must provide its own driver, but the car must be requested by KC26. In the event of a conflict, KC26 will determine who has priority. This is final.  
§2. The use of the vehicle must be paid for, and for this the team has to pay €0,17/km.
- Art 14. Every team (serious and fun) can request equipment, but this request must be submitted by KC26. The cost of the requested materials will be billed to the team.
- Art 15. §1. At activities of teams (serious and fun) that offer food or drinks for sale, these foods and drinks will always be offered free of charge to the entire KC26 first. After approval of KC26, the activity may proceed.  
§2. KC26 may participate in activities free of charge for all activities organized by the team(s).
- Art 16. Every team (serious and fun) must provide an additional item of textile, if the team provides textile for its members. The additional item will be paid by KC26 and will be used for the archives of Industria.
- Art 17. Each member of each team (serious and fun) must introduce themselves with a handwritten letter. This letter must be neatly handwritten and must be at least 200 words long. The letter must also include the following:
- The member's role in the upcoming team.
  - The member's favourite colour
  - A movie character
- The deadline of this letter is May 3, 2026 and it must be delivered to the mailbox in the Industria room. If this is not done, KC26 can impose sanctions.
- Art 18. Every team (serious and fun) must fill the shifts assigned by KC26 on campaign day. Failure to fill these shifts means that KC26 can impose sanctions.
- Art 19. The serious team has to write out their vision, which is done by a team/vision presentation on their election team website (which can be posted one month in advance) that can be posted on the Industria website.
- Art 20. As a clarification/extension of the electoral regulations:
- No material from a team (serious and fun) may be found on partially neutral terrain.
  - No passive campaigning may be conducted on partially neutral terrain until the passive week.

Art 21. Failure to meet a deadline will be penalized by KC26. The sanction will be chosen by KC26. The teams must respect the following deadlines:

- February 4, 2026: First registration for serious teams.
- March 4, 2026: Second registration serious teams.
- March 22, 2026: Dates and locations for all activities of all teams.
- April 4, 2026: Finished plan for all activities for all teams.
- April 4, 2026: Registration fun teams.
- April 13, 2026: Application for bracket IV for serious teams.
- April 20, 2026: Application for bracket II and II for serious teams.
- May 3, 2026: Final list of members for serious teams.
- June 4, 2026: Closing of the open accounting without debts for the serious teams.
